E-Safety Home-School Agreement

Pupils have agreed to follow the E-Safety guidance at school and at home.

This guidance is to:

- Understand and know what they should be using on the Internet and be aware of what is appropriate for their age.
- Ask an adult before they use devices such as iPads and mobile phones.
- Understand and know that to use most social media and apps they need to be 13 years old or above and if they are younger they should not be using it. This includes Facebook, WhatsApp, Snapchat and Instagram.
- To check the age restriction for games they play on a games console and remember not to talk to people on them.
- Use Safe Search and ask an adult if they need to use a different search engine.
- Understand and know what personal information is.
- Never share personal information with anyone online, even if someone tells them they know them.
- Be kind to people online, just as they would if they were face-to-face with them.
- Share their E-Safety learning around their school and remind their peers both inside and outside school how to keep themselves safe online.
