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#### What have each year been up to?

## **EYFS**

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This half term the EYFS children have been working on the topic of 'going places'. The children have especially enjoyed learning about London and the Royal Family, ready for the Queen's Jubilee celebrations.









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### <u>Year 1</u>

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#### Year 2

Year 2 have been learning about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole. The children had a great day at the "hospital" where they had x-rays taken, carried out triage on patients and completed admission forms for their patients.



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## Year 3

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Pupils in Year 3 have been learning about Ancient Greece and how the Olympics began. They held a Greek Olympics and competed in teams in a variety of sports. They also took part in archery and were taught how to shoot safely and accurately.

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## Year 4

Pupils in Year 4 have been studying the Ancient Egyptians. They enjoyed learning about the civilization and dressed up to launch the topic. They have also been learning all about the digestive system and are currently investigating the effects of sugar on teeth!
