<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Opportunities to listen in a range of situations Respond to two and three step instructions Sing traditional songs and rhymes Ask and answer questions Add more detail when holding a conversation <p><u>How to help me at home:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage me to talk in a range of situations, especially with unfamiliar adults or children Help me to ask and answer questions Sing simple songs and rhymes with me 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Play independently and with others Show more independence in dressing and undressing – attempting own zip on coat, putting on hats and gloves and putting on own shoes Show confidence in sharing own thoughts and ideas <p><u>How to help me at home:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set daily tasks for me to complete independently Allow me to take part in dressing myself with a focus on shoes and socks Practise with zips, poppers and buttons 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fine motor and gross motor skill activities Use of outdoor and indoor spaces for physical play Finger manipulation activities Develop movement and balancing skills Practise doing buttons and zips Practising taking off and putting on shoes/socks <p><u>How to help me at home:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise throwing and catching a small ball Practise kicking a small ball towards a target 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Opportunities to explore elements of the fruits of the spirit - joy and self control Learn about the Bible and some old testament stories Learn about important world celebrations – St George's day 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> FOCUS: Amazing Animals Learn about farm animals and their babies Learn about the life cycle of a chick Begin to learn about where our food comes from Learn about different animal habitats Leading to a hands on encounter with more unfamiliar animals <p><u>How to help me at home:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share a range of books together Take me to the local library to learn some animal facts If you have a pet, allow the children to actively participate in feeding, cleaning, brushing etc Go on a bug hunt

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enjoy sharing books and listening to stories Begin to recite well known nursery rhymes, songs and chants Recall repetitive phrases from well known tales and stories Recognise their first name in print Begin to name alphabet letters by name and sound <p><u>How to help me at home:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share Nursery book pack contents each week 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Making marks in a variety of different ways Learning about writing for meaning eg creating cards, labels and stories Form the letters in their first name Encourage me to hold my pencil correctly Begin to form recognisable letters Write my name on any completed work to take home <p><u>How to help me at home:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage me to write my first name in birthday cards Encourage me to make marks using a range of different media – pencils, pens, paint, foam, sand 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recite numbers to 10 then 20 – forwards and backwards Recreate simple repeating patterns Talk about the properties of 2D shapes Explore capacity and weight Name number numerals to 10 Begin to find totals of objects by counting 1:1 Take part in problem solving activities <p><u>How to help me at home:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise counting small groups of objects 1:1 Practise counting in order to 10 then 20 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use all their senses to explore and investigate Begin to make sense of their own life story Make links to the past, present and future Understand that not everyone has the same beliefs Explore seasonal changes Learn about important world celebrations Explore life cycles Care for our environment <p><u>How to help me at home</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage me to ask questions and find answers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use own imagination to explore art, music, dance and role play activities Experience different sensory activities Handle tools with care Colour mix Sing songs Play collaborative playground games <p><u>How to help me at home:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Opportunities to be creative – dance, craft and music
